

RESTRICTION OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES DIRECTIVE.

The above directive comes into force in July 2006 and bans the use of certain hazardous materials. Principally they are:

Lead

Chromium VI

Mercury

Cadmium

Polybrominated Biphenyl

Pentabrominated Diphenyl ether
